EV Charge Point

The new electric vehicle charge point in the Memorial Hall car park is now operational and available to use.

20mph Speed Limit

Following consultation, the majority of residents support a 20mph limit in the village. We are moving ahead with the application.

Budget and Precept

The precept is the part of your council tax that goes directly to the Parish Council to fund local services and community projects.

For 2026/27, the Parish Council precept will increase by 8.55%, which equates to an additional £6.59 per year for an average Band D property.

This funding supports local services such as:

- Grass cutting and maintenance of open spaces
 - Play area upkeep and equipment
 - Defibrillators for emergency use
 - Speeding mitigation measures
 - Grants to support local organisations
